#### NOTES TO THE NOTICE OF THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING:

## **Entitlement to attend and vote**

- Only those members registered in the Company's register of members at 11am on 3 March 2020 or, if the meeting is adjourned, 48 hours prior to the time of the adjourned meeting, shall be entitled to attend, speak and vote at the meeting. Changes to the register of members after the relevant deadline shall be disregarded in determining the rights of any person to attend and vote at the meeting.
- If you wish to attend the meeting in person you must arrive promptly at the above date at time, and may be required to provide photographic identification.

## **Appointment of proxies**

- As a member of the Company, you are entitled to appoint a proxy to exercise all or any of your rights to attend, speak and vote at the meeting and you should have received a form of proxy with this notice of meeting. You can only appoint a proxy using the procedures set out in these notes and the form of proxy. A proxy need not be a member of the Company.
- A member may appoint more than one proxy provided each proxy is appointed to exercise rights attached to different shares. A member may not appoint more than one proxy to exercise rights attached to any one share.
